CHANGES ARE COMING Cancellation Policy

CRMTA is changing our Cancellation Policy

- If you are required to take a CRMTA audit and you fail, your membership will be cancelled, and you will be declined membership.
- If your membership is cancelled, CRMTA informs insurance companies immediately that you no longer have membership with CRMTA and can decline claims as of that date.
- Rejoining CRMTA after your membership has been cancelled will result in you having to requalify for membership based on the requirements in place at the time of rejoining.

To Avoid Being Cancelled

- Make sure you have submitted a <u>completed</u> renewal application and all required documentation by your renewal date.
- Make sure all your documentation is legible and clear.
- If you want to keep your CRMTA number, make sure you renew your membership on time.
